.3 This mistake will take care of all the above issues, but you may run into errors in the future if your system changes in some way. In the best case scenario, your system will come with disk partitioning software that will take care of all of this for you. Windows 10 will then use this system to install your OS. The tradeoff for this is that you have to rely on Microsoft's system to tell you that the disk is full. If you still want to manually partition, you can click on the Start Menu and search for partition. Here are the steps: Click Start > Computer > Right-click Computer > Manage. Click Change Storage settings. Locate the partition you want to delete and right-click it. Click Delete partition. You are done! Just boot into Windows. Windows 10 Installation On Hard Disk In Windows 10, the system will tell you that it needs to remove the installation media and reboot. If the partition is full, your system will take a long time to boot. If you're a manual partitioner, you can manually remove the partition (make sure it's empty). Boot the installation media and choose Repair your PC. Choose Troubleshoot > Advanced options > Startup Repair. Press "R" to roll back to the last safe boot, then "E" to edit the commands. Press "X" to delete the partitions. You should now be able to boot Windows. Try Uninstalling apps If you've installed a lot of apps, you can uninstall them to free up disk space. Search the Start Menu for the app you want to uninstall. Right-click it and select Uninstall. This will uninstall the app. Windows 10 Troubleshooting If your Windows 10 system is having problems booting, try some of the following: Make sure that the hard drive is connected and turned on. Try unplugging the AC adapter and plugging it back in. Press the "Start" button on the keyboard and then hold the "Shift" key on the keyboard. Press "Eject" on the keyboard. The system will boot into the Windows Recovery screen. Select Troubleshoot > Advanced options > Startup Repair. Reboot 82157476af
